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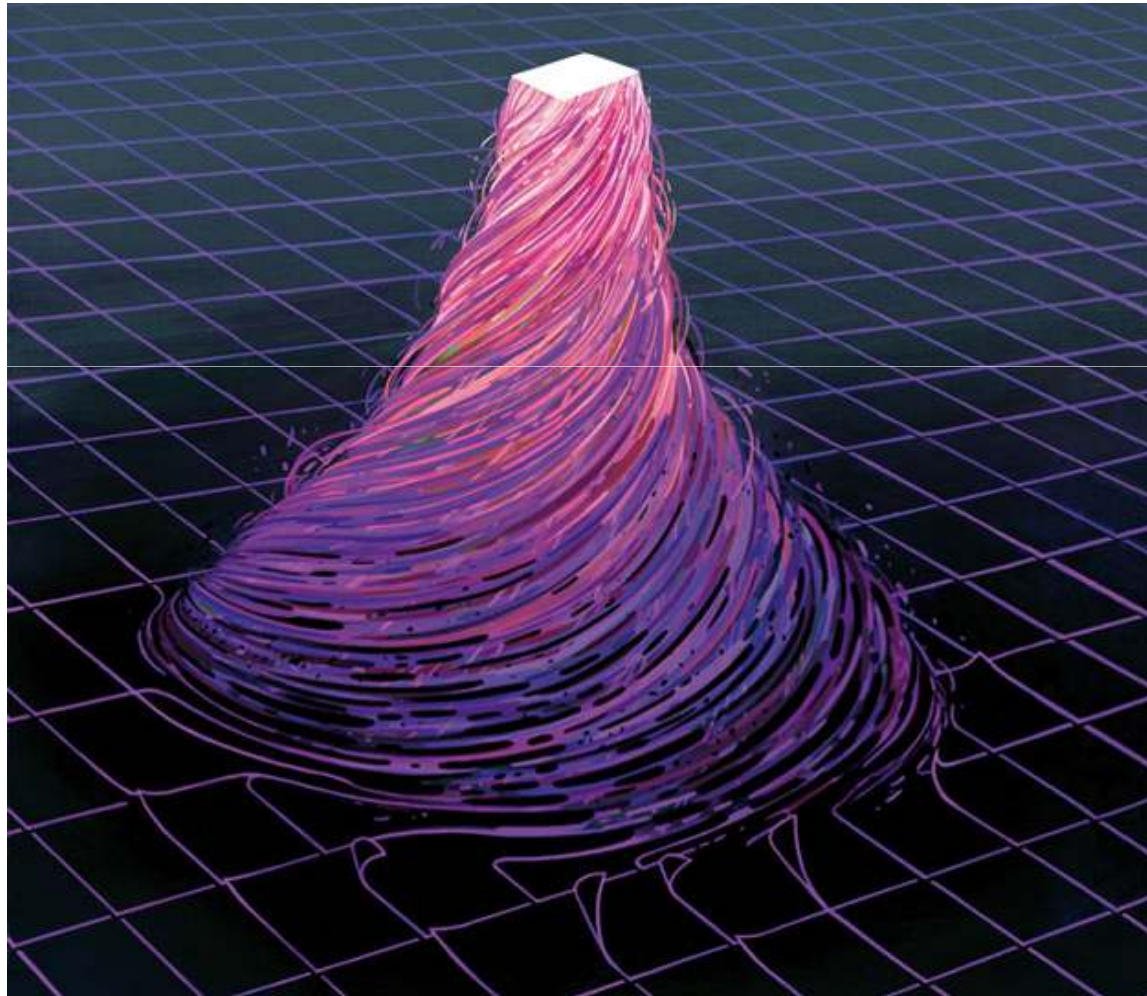

Dr. Randy Schekman
 - “...open access journals are superior to traditional scientific journals because they are not concerned with the selling of expensive subscriptions and can accept all papers that meet quality standards, with no artificial caps.”
 - “... called on scientists to no longer publish in “luxury” high-impact journals, and instead to publish in open-access journals.”

 - “I see more poorly written papers published in a plethora of new, open-access journals than anywhere else. I can only conclude that open-access journals have done more to compromise peer review in the last 5 years than anything else I can think of. This will ultimately challenge the validity of published scientific data in ways that are alarming to me.”

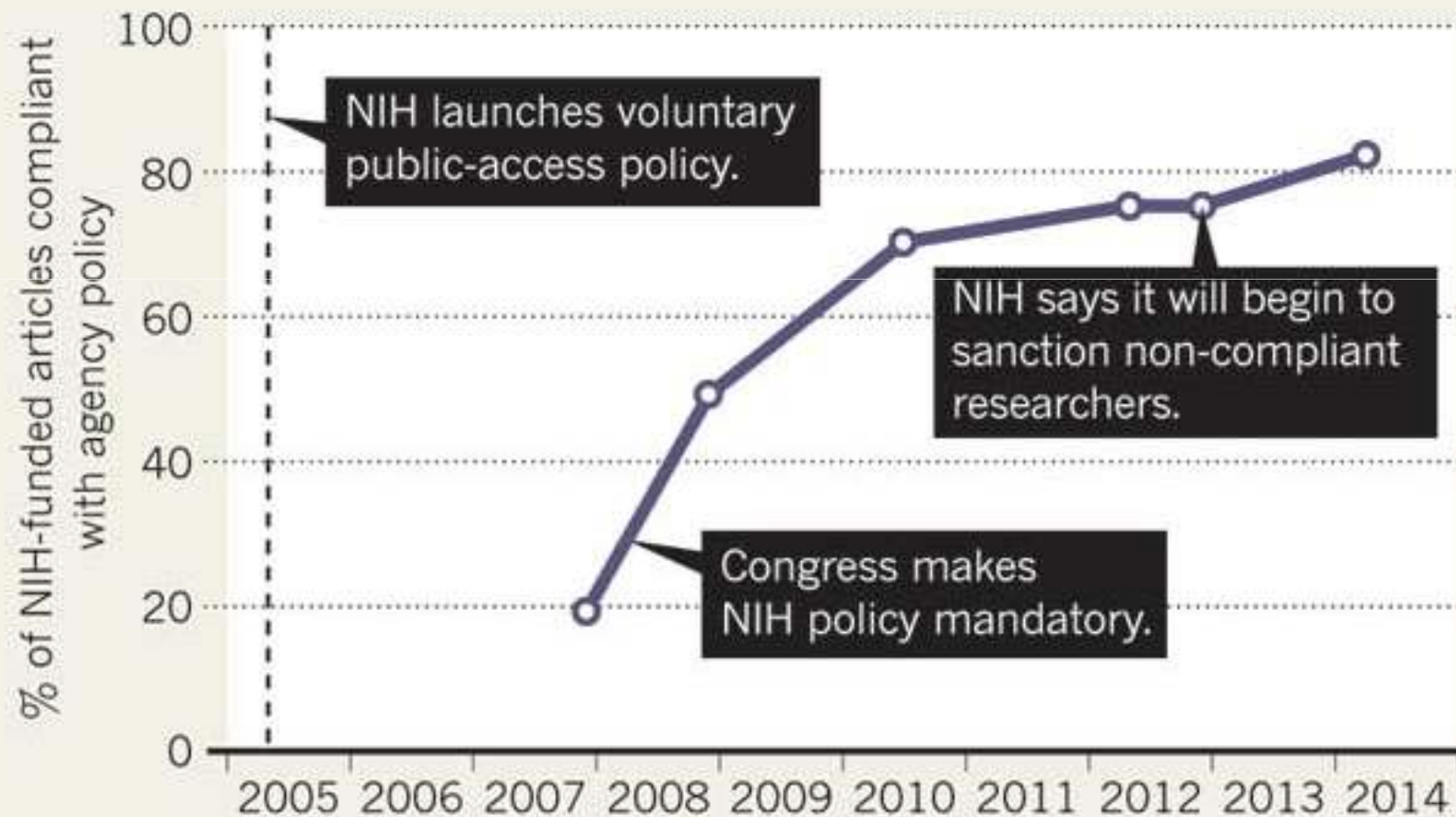

Bogus and counterfeit.

The Polish journal *Sylwan* has been hijacked — sort of. Unlike previous journal hijackings, in this case the legitimate journal has a website, and a bogus website pretends to be the journal's English edition.

The authentic journal is in Polish and published in Poland. The hijacked version of the website purports to be the “English Edition” of the journal. *Sylwan* is a forestry (silviculture) journal, and according to its *Wikipedia* article (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Sylwan>) has been published since 1802, with the current publisher being the Polish Forestry Society.

To trick people, the counterfeit website contains much correct information lifted from the authentic website.

Someone has edited the *Wikipedia* article to add the counterfeit web address. Here are the two websites:



Kako provjeriti pouzdanost izdavača?

- Check that the publisher provides
 - full, verifiable contact information, including address, on the journal site.
 - be cautious of those that provide only web contact forms
- Check that a journal's editorial board lists recognized experts with full affiliations
 - contact some of them and ask about their experience with the journal or publisher
- Check that the journal prominently displays its policy for author fees
- Be wary of e-mail invitations to submit to journals or to become editorial board members
- Read some of the journal's published articles and assess their quality
 - contact past authors to ask about their experience
- Check that a journal's peer-review process is clearly described
 - try to confirm that a claimed impact factor is correct
- Find out whether the journal is a member of an industry association that vets its members, such as the Directory of Open Access Journal or the Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association
- Use common sense, as you would when shopping online
 - if something looks fishy, proceed with caution
